CHARACTERS: Customer and Travel Agent. Agent starts out perky and helpful but slowly

becomes irritated at customer. Customer becomes increasingly frustrated.

SETTING: bare stage RUN TIME: 2 minutes

SCRIPTURE/BASED ON: Matthew 7:114, John 14:6

AT RISE: Customer calls Travel Agent. They speak on the phone.

- Z: Anywhere Travel Agency. We get you anywhere. How may I help you?
- C: I'd like to go to New York.
- Z: Fabulous. I can get you on a flight at any time of the day. When would you like to leave?
- C: How about 10 am?
- Z: Great. I've got you booked on the 10 am to San Francisco.
- C: No. I want to go to New York.
- Z: Ok. How about a flight on Anywhere Air that leaves at 11 am? I can get you upgraded to first class.
- C: This is to New York, right?
- Z: It goes to Paris.
- C: I don't want to go to Paris. I want to go to New York.
- Z: Fine. How about taking the train?
- C: Ok. Where does the train go?
- Z: You know what they say, "All roads lead to Rome."
- C: I don't want to end up in Rome. I want to go to New York.
- Z: That's a pretty intolerant attitude.
- C: What?
- Z: Insisting on going to New York, You sound like those intolerant Christians who think Jesus is the only way to heaven.
- C: Jesus is the way, the truth and the life.
- Z: He may be \underline{A} way. Focus on the journey and the destination will take care of itself. Now, how about a direct flight with no stops or layovers? I can get you to Denver by 6 pm tonight.
