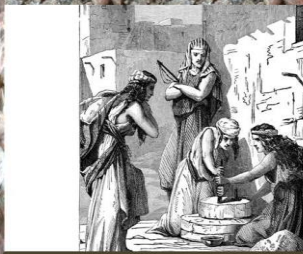




Person/event 1 Samuel 30: 3

Person/event 1 Samuel 21: 9

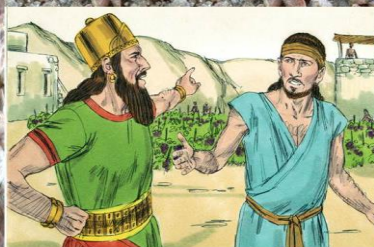
Ahimelech the priest replied, "The sword of Goliath the Philistine ... is here ... If you want to take it for yourself, then take it, for there isn't another one here."

Person/event 1 Samuel 30: 19

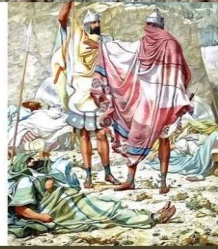
Nothing of theirs was missing from the youngest to the oldest including the sons and daughters, of all the plunder the Amalekites had taken. David got everything back.





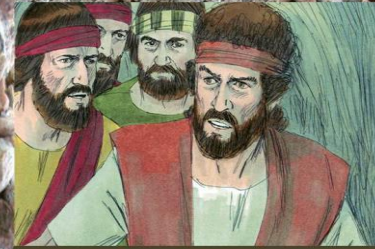
Person/event 1 Samuel 17:51

David ran and stood over him. He grabbed the Philistine's sword, pulled it from its sheath, and used it to kill him. Then he cut off his head.



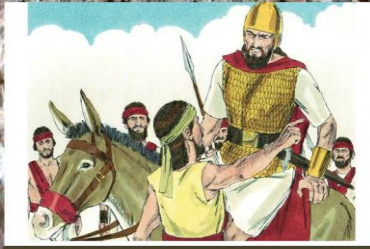
Person/event 1 Samuel 26:12
