




David ran and stood over him. He grabbed the Philistine's sword, pulled it from its sheath, and used it to kill him. Then he cut off his head.




Person/event 1 Samuel 26:12

David put his hand in the bag, took out a stone, slung it, and hit the Philistine on his forehead. The stone sank into his forehead, and he fell on his face to the ground.




Person/event 1 Samuel 28:8



Michal warned David, "If you don't escape tonight, you will be dead tomorrow!" So she lowered David from the window, and he fled and escaped




Every time the Philistine commanders came out to fight, David was more successful than all of Saul's officers. So his name became well known.


