He was big and bad and 9 feet tall but he was no match for a boy with God on his side. I bet those of you who knew the answer got that knowledge by listening to or reading your Bibles.

How did I know God was bigger than a nine foot giant? I listened when people spoke of God and his power. I had the knowledge (*tapping his head*). Brains and strength. (*flexes his muscle*)

I bet many of you have listened to Bible stories and know I became king. Who knew that? (acknowledge those who raise their hands) Here's something you may NOT have known. God required every king to make his own personal copy of the law of God.

Who has a Bible I can borrow? (*Thanks person and holds Bible up*) I didn't have to copy this whole thing. The scriptures were much shorter when I was alive. But still, it was hard work copying it over by hand. We didn't have computers to type on. We had to write it by hand.

I wasn't just a giant slayer and a king. I was also a writer. Who knows which book of the Bible (*Holding up Bible*) has my songs and poems in it? (*Get audience to tell you Psalms*) That's right. Psalms. And in Psalms 119, the longest chapter in the entire Bible, I talk about how good the word of God is. It's better than food. It's better than sleep. It's even the best friend you can have. And I had a great best friend named Jonathan – but that's another story. You can read about it where? (*Get audience to say the Bible*)

Absolutely. Since none of you are going to become king, you don't have to make your own copy of the law of God. But I would recommend studying it, memorizing it and sharing God's word with others. Talk about it at home and when you travel. (*Returns Bible to owner*) Like I always say – it's a lamp – I guess you could think of it as a flashlight – for your feet.
