CHARACTERS: 9, doubling possible COSTUMES: none specified PROPS: none specified SETTING: Israel in the time of Christ RUN TIME: 4 minutes SCRIPTURE/BASED ON: Matthew 13

- A: Jesus told parables.
- B: That fulfilled what was spoken through the prophet.
- A: I will open my mouth in parables,
- B: I will utter things hidden since the creation of the world
- A: One day Jesus told this parable.
- JESUS: The kingdom of heaven is like a man who sowed good seed in his field.
- B: But while everyone was sleeping, his enemy came and sowed weeds among the wheat, and went away.
- A: When the wheat sprouted and formed heads, then the weeds also appeared.
- B: The owner's servants came to him and said
- SERVANT 1: Sir, didn't you sow good seed in your field?
- SERVANT 2: Where then did the weeds come from?
- OWNER: An enemy did this.
- SERVANT 2: Do you want us to go and pull them up?
- OWNER: No, because while you are pulling the weeds, you may root up the wheat with them.
- SERVANT 1: Shall we let both grow together until the harvest?

OWNER: Yes. I will tell the harvesters to first collect the weeds and tie them in bundles to be burned; then gather the wheat and bring it into my barn.

A: Jesus left the crowd and went into the house.
