



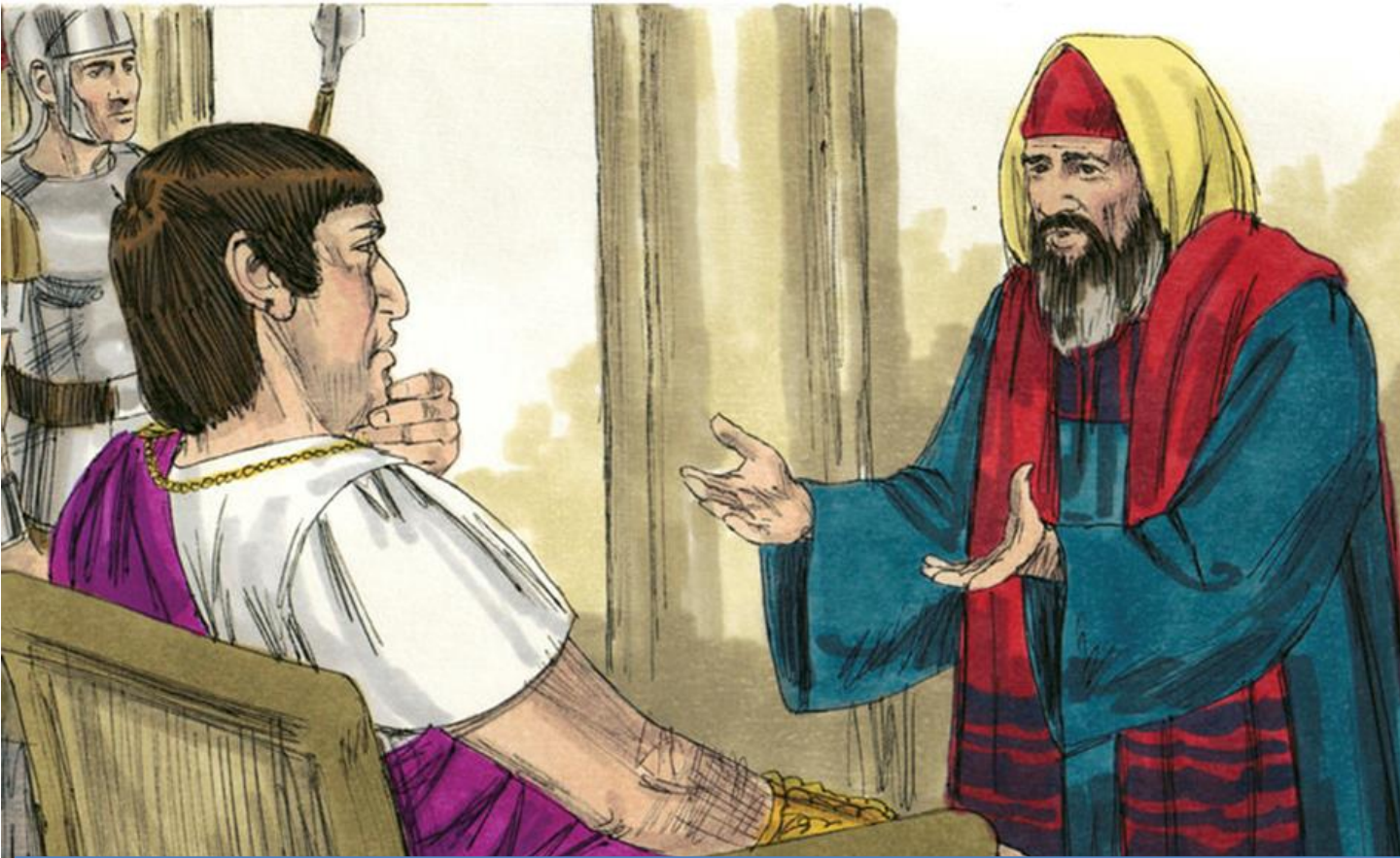
Tempus Fugit

Tempus Fugit clues the 3 number combo lock; the Pilate Inscription clues searchers to look at the Bible passages where keys are hidden and words circled with UV pen



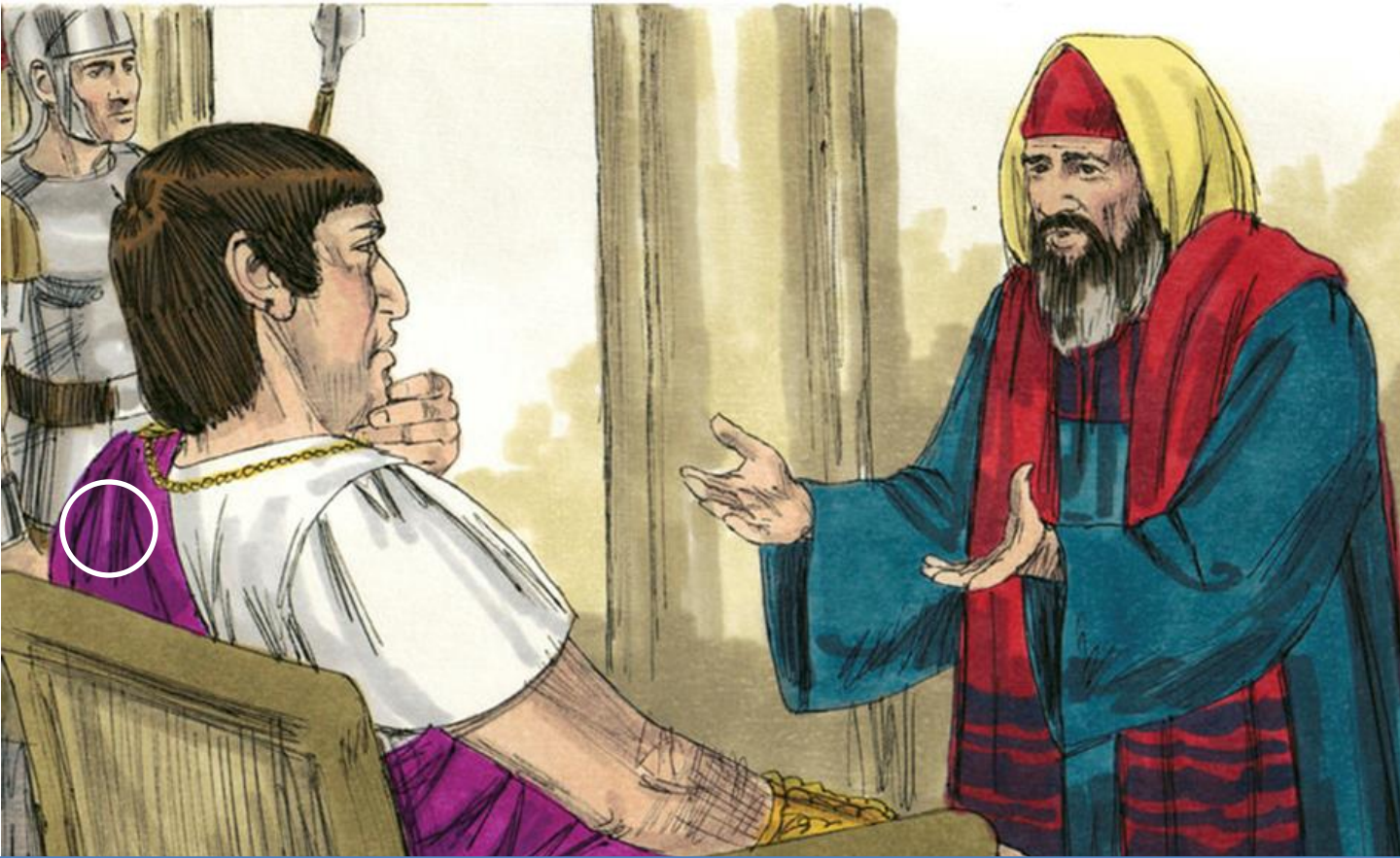

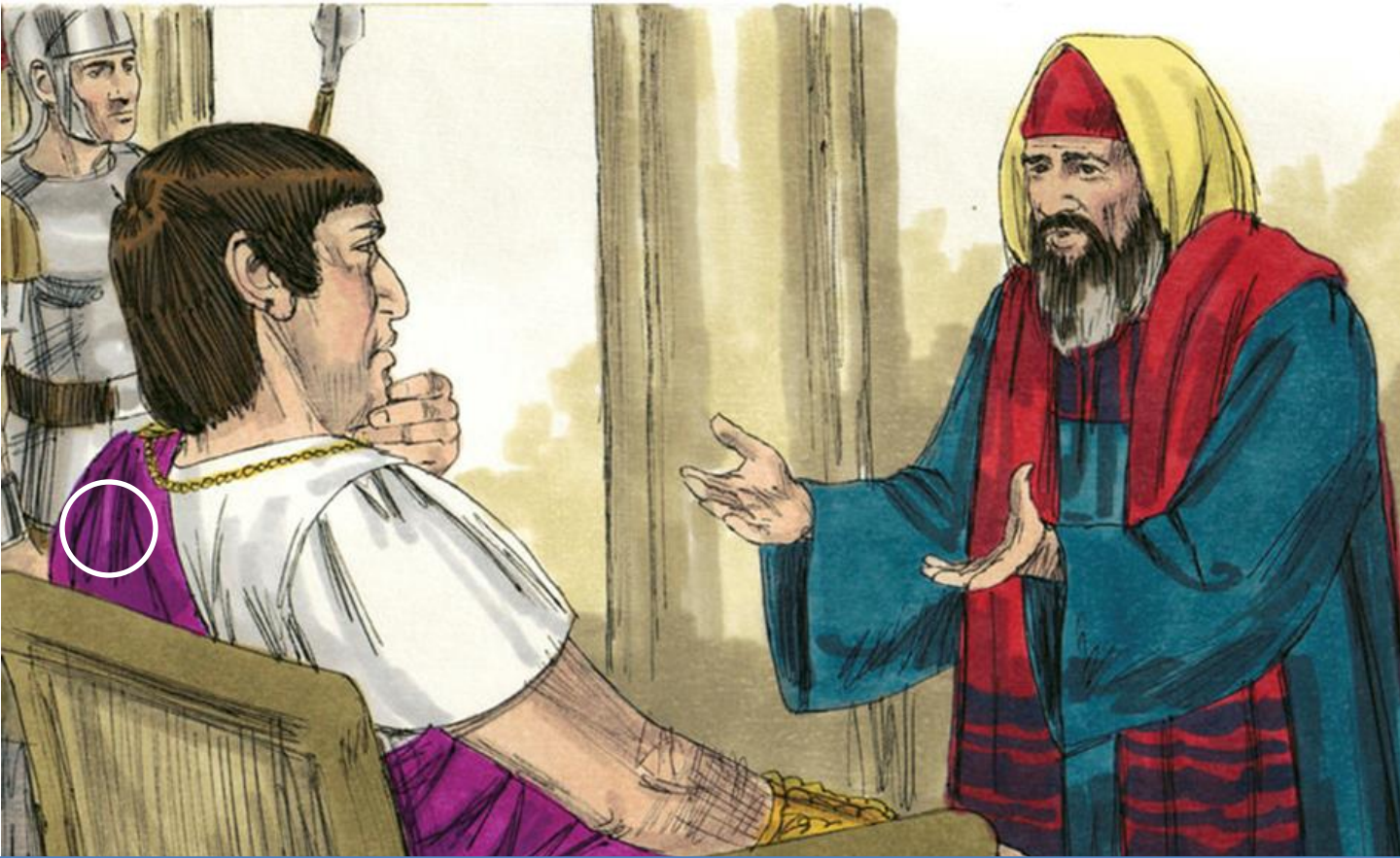

Answer key:

With the ultraviolet pen, draw circles as indicated to clue the colors purple and blue for the color combo lock. Then cut apart and cut into puzzle pieces, put in envelop & leave in room to be found.

Answer key:

Print and post or leave in room to be found. The numbers on the “Johns” indicate 5 scriptures. The common word found in all these scriptures is “truth”, the word to open the 5 letter combo lock.
