LEADER: Praise the LORD, O my soul.

LEADER: He wraps himself in light as with a garment;

ALL: He stretches out the heavens like a tent







LEADER: God lays the beams of his upper chambers on their waters.

ALL: He makes the clouds his chariot and rides on the wings of the wind.







## LEADER: He makes winds his messengers,

ALL: flames of fire his servants





LEADER: He set the earth on its foundations;

ALL: it can never be moved.







LEADER: You covered it with the deep as with a garment;

ALL: the waters stood above the mountains.







LEADER: But at your rebuke the waters fled,

ALL: at the sound of your thunder they took to flight;







LEADER: They flowed over the mountains, they went down into the valleys,

ALL: to the place you assigned for them.







## LEADER: You set a boundary they cannot cross;

ALL: never again will they cover the earth.







LEADER: He makes springs pour water into the ravines;
ALL: it flows between the mountains.







## LEADER: They give water to all the beasts of the field;

ALL: the wild donkeys quench their thirst.







LEADER: The birds of the air nest by the waters;

ALL: they sing among the branches.







LEADER: He waters the mountains from his upper chambers;

ALL: the earth is satisfied by the fruit of his work.
